### Degree Requirements

#### **Total Semester Credit Hours Required**

30-39 semester credit hours (SCH) minimum with at least 21 SCH of course work in the major.

Students will take at least 9 SCH in U.S. history and 3 SCH in non-U.S. history. Students are encouraged to distribute the 9 U.S. history SCH across the following fields: 17th or 18th century US history, 19th century U.S. history, and U.S. history since 1900.

### **Thesis Option**

Minimum of 30 semester credit hours, including 6 SCH for the thesis.

### **Special Requirement**

No grade lower than B can be counted toward meeting the minimum number of semester credit hours required. Students enrolled in the Graduate Certificate in Political Science will complete and defend a portfolio that describes their course work and research in political science.

### **Final Examination**

An oral defense of the thesis or professional paper/project is required.
