Our Graduate Certificate in History is ideally suited for:

1. Texas high school teachers who have an M.A. in a field other than history and want to teach history in the dual credit classroom.
2. Teachers who have an M.A. in a field other than history and want to teach history in the community college classroom.
3. Individuals who are interested in graduate work in history but aren't ready to fully commit to a graduate program.

A prior M.A. is not required for admission. However, Texas state law mandates that dual credit and community college teachers hold an M.A. in any field AND 18 hours in the subject they are teaching. Our Graduate Certificate Program in History meets the 18-hour requirement to teach history.
