GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN MULTICULTURAL & DIVERSITY STUDIES FOR THE S.L.P.

This 12 semester credit hour certificate program prepares graduate students to assess and treat communication disorders in culturally and linguistically diverse populations. The program includes online academic coursework and a supervised clinical practicum opportunity and is available to students concurrently enrolled in the M.S. in Speech-Language Pathology program.

Marketable Skills

Degree Requirements Total Semester Credit Hours Required

12 semester credit hours (SCH).

Interested students will be required to apply and be accepted to the graduate program in speech-language pathology. The required coursework includes 9 SCH of online academic classes and 3 SCH of a clinical practicum experience with at least 75 clock hours of assessing and treating culturally and linguistically diverse individuals. Students must earn grades of A or B in all classes and successfully pass a portfolio examination.
