Marketable Skills

Defined by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's 60x30 Strategic Plan (<https://reportcenter.highered.texas.gov/agency-publication/miscellaneous/thecb-60x30-strategic-plan/>) as, "Those skills valued by employers that can be applied in a variety of work settings, including interpersonal, cognitive, and applied skills areas. 1. Understanding the integration of nutrition into specific health benefits or disease conditions.

4. Interpret scientific literature in the field, and author-written and verbal communications on findings.
5. Author-written and verbal communications for various audience levels.
6. Listen to and interpret scientific presentations and publications.
