Admissions

All applicants must meet the general undergraduate admission requirements (<https://catalog.twu.edu/undergraduate/admission-information/>).

To declare the pre-medical track of the B.S. in Biology, the following additional criteria must be met:

1. A student must attend a Pre-Health Informational Workshop hosted by TWU Pre-Health Advising. Multiple workshop dates will be offered in the Fall and Spring semesters. Documentation of attendance at the workshop will be provided to the student's academic advisor.
2. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required to declare the pre-medical track of the B.S. in Biology. Students on this track must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. If the cumulative GPA drops below 3.0, the student must raise the cumulative GPA to 3.0 within two semesters. After that, the student will be removed from the pre-medical track and placed on the general track of the B.S. in Biology. This GPA minimum is intended to ensure student readiness for applying to professional programs such as medical, dental, veterinary, or pharmacy schools.
