### **Additional Requirements**

At the time of enrollment in nursing courses, the student must provide proof of:

- Current unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse in the United States (bridge program) OR enrollment in a partnering community college's ADN program (blended program).
- 2. Current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification from the American Heart Association.
- Current required immunizations as specified by TWU College of Nursing approved vendor (e.g., Castlebranch).
- Negative drug testing and cleared criminal background screening by a company designated by the College of Nursing (background check must be cleared for admission to program).
- 5. Proof of personal health insurance (required by clinical facilities).
- 6. Completion of HIPAA training.

- 7. Social Security Number.
- 8. Photo Identification.
